(4) ECTS grading scale :UCL uses a single ECTS grading scale which is based upon the grades obtaining in all the programmes during the last five academic years. It is reviewed each year..

ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition	UCL Grade
A	10	EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor errors	$17 \leq n \leq 20$
B	25	VERY GOOD – above the average standard but with some errors	$15 \leq n < 17$
C	30	GOOD – generally sound work with a number of notable errors	$13 \leq n < 15$
D	25	SATISFACTORY – fair but with significant shortcomings	$11 \leq n < 13$
E	10	SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria	$10 \leq n < 11$
F	-	FAIL – considerable further work is required	$n < 10$
