

Chad P. Bown currently is a Senior Economist in the Development Economics Research Group (DECRG) of the World Bank in Washington, DC. Previously, he was a Professor at Brandeis University where he taught courses on the global economy, international trade policy and institutions, and international trade disputes to undergraduate students, as well as in the M.A., M.B.A., Ph.D. program.

Bown's research spans the economics of international trade laws and institutions, trade policy negotiations, and trade frictions. His recent research examines WTO dispute settlement, the international use of antidumping and safeguard trade policies, the integration of China, India, and other developing countries into the global trading system, and the response of exporting firms to new market access opportunities.

Chad Bown received his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
