

Particular conditions related to the exam regulations (including credit attribution and recognition), deliberation and exam jury

The programme management committee will inform the students of the study regulations applicable to this program.

For issues not explicitly regulated by the programme committee or by the present agreement, the rules of “Laurea magistrale” at Unimi will be applicable to all students of the present programme during their stay at Unimi and the rules of the “Master en Sciences économiques, orientation générale” jointly organised by UCL and FUNDP will be applicable to all students of the present programme during their stay at UCL/FUNDP.

Mark conversion

All marks gained during the joint degree program shall be converted to ECTS grades as shown in the following correspondence table:

The conversion table can be modified according to changes in the grading system and in the distribution of grades in the three institutions. The conversion table may be the object of further discussion between the Partners.

This correspondence table will be communicated to the students.

The thesis.

All students will complete one Master thesis that will be supervised by professors of the three institutions.

Thesis defence

The thesis committee at each partner University will be established upon own national regulations. At least one member of the thesis committee must be a professor affiliated with UCL/FUNDP and at least one must be a professor affiliated with Unimi. The defence may take place by videoconference.

Deliberation and proclamation

The home university will exchange information on students’ careers with the host university. Students’ deliberation and proclamation will take place according to the rules prevailing at the host university. For Unimi students, the joint degree will be conferred upon deliberation and proclamation at UCL/FUNDP acting also on behalf of Unimi. For UCL/FUNDP students, the joint degree will be conferred upon deliberation and proclamation at Unimi acting also on behalf of UCL/FUNDP.

Awarding of mention and voto di laurea

In order to harmonize the final marks, Unimi and UCL/FUNDP will make use of the following correspondence table between Unimi's voto di laurea and UCL/FUNDP's mention:
