

Particular conditions related to the exam regulations (including credit attribution and recognition), deliberation and exam jury

The programme management committee will inform the students of the study regulations applicable to this program.

For issues not explicitly regulated by the programme committee or by the present convention, the rules of Master in International economics at the University of Warsaw will be applicable to all first year students of the present programme and the rules of the Master of Arts in Economics, General, Research focus, jointly organised by UCL and FUNDP will be applicable to second year students.

Mark conversion

The conversion of the examinations marks will follow the ECTS guidelines. The conversion table can be modified according to the changes in the grading system and in the distribution. The conversion could be the object of further discussion between the Partners. It will be announced to the students at the beginning of each academic year and will remain valid for the full curriculum (120 credits) of any given student.

The thesis

All students will complete only one Master thesis that will be supervised by professors from UCL or FUNDP. Readers may be chosen from amongst professors from UCL, FUNDP or WU.

Each teacher in the program takes his/her fair share in the supervising of theses.

Students are requested to deliver a note describing their thesis project according to a schedule announced in the first semester of the second Year of the Program. This note must be approved by their supervisor.

Students will give an oral defence of their "thesis" before the thesis advisor and reader. If the reader is from Warsaw University, s/he may send his/her comments by email to the Louvain or Namur thesis advisor and have a professor teaching on the program stand in for him/her.

Deliberation

First year

Students deliberation will take place according to the rules prevailing at the WU

Second Year

Students deliberation will take place according to the joint rules prevailing at the UCL and FUNDP.

Awarding of mention and voto di laurea

A correspondence table between WU , UCL and FUNDP's mention will be created in order to harmonize the final marks.

The jury, however, can decide to give a more favorable mention to a student than what a strict application of the table above would require, according to the usual rules of the universities.

The correspondence table could be the object of further discussion between the Partners, who will agree on a joint scale.
