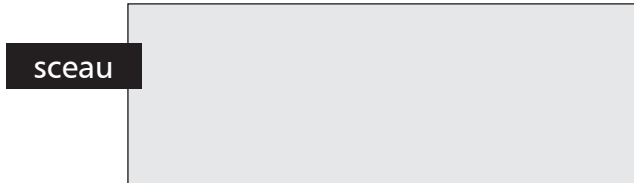

In order to guarantee the easy follow-up of the file, please take note of the following information :

- 1° the guarantor must be a person residing in Belgium or in a bordering country and having fixed incomes in the country ;
- 2° its signature must be legalized by a proper authority (Municipal authorities) ;
- 3° if the student has dependents, it is necessary to extend the financial support to these people ;
- 4° by signing the pledge of financial support, the guarantor commits himself to being actually responsible in case of financial default of the recipient in the framework of his studies.
