Before joining and helping to set up CSR Europe in 1996, Jan worked for the [European Commission](#) Directorate General on Employment, Industrial Relations and Social Affairs. He was involved in the European Poverty III Programme and the creation of the [European Platform of Social Non-Governmental Organisations](#). He then coordinated the launch of the [European Business Declaration against Social Exclusion](#) - an initiative launched by President Jacques Delors and 20 European Business Leaders in January 1995.

Building on the Declaration, he co-coordinated the creation of [CSR Europe](#) in 1996 and contributed to the [European Appeal of Heads of State and Governments on CSR](#) in March 2000. Since 2002 he represents CSR Europe in the Coordination Committee of [the European Multistakeholder Forum on CSR](#). In 2005, together with a core group of CSR Europe members, Jan was actively involved in the making of the [European Business Roadmap on CSR](#) which set the ground of the [European Alliance for CSR](#) which is now central in the renewed European Policy on CSR (2006-2010). Based on 15 years experience within CSR Europe and building upon the results of the European Alliance for CSR, Jan is in the process of supporting companies, business organisations and stakeholders to shape "[The Responsible Enterprise 2020](#)" to be launched in 2010.

As from 1997 he played a leading role in the establishment of what has become in 2002 the [European Academy of Business in Society](#) (EABIS). Since March 2007, he is visiting Professor at the [Louvain School of Management](#) where he now also co-animates the [Louvain CSR Network](#) since May 2009.
