Learning outcomes	At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to:  At the end of the course, the students will be able:  • to analyse the linguistic and cultural situation of young immigrants and understand the most current errors made by these pupils in the light of their language/culture of origin;  • to consider possible transfers of tools of French as a foreign or second language (FLES);  • to devise teaching methods for teaching in a multicultural context.				
Evaluation methods	<ol> <li>Written report and oral defense of this report (70%).</li> <li>Reading assignments (20%) and collaborative annotation of reading material on the <i>Perusall</i> platform, before each session. This assessment is automated by the platform.</li> <li>Class participation (10%) is evaluated formatively (i.e. not assessing the <i>quality</i> of participation but encouraging its occurrence), encouraging questions, interventions, and comments, as well as active participation in group discussions and exercises.</li> </ol>
