ECGE1316 Économétrie [30h+15h] (5)

- a choice of 5 credits from amongst :

ECGE1312 Économie publique [30h+15h](5 credits)

ECGE1311 Économie industrielle [30h+15h] (5 credits)

ECGE1313 Économie européenne [30h+15h] (5 credits)
