For **EU/EFTA citizens**: the nomination has to be submitted by the online form min 1 month before the beginning of stay.

Summer semester: 15th October

ERASMUS+ GUIDELINES

NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCESS

A sending institution nominates its students **only** via [online nomination form](#).

Please be aware that nominations sent via email will not be accepted.

Application instructions will be emailed to those students whose nomination was accepted, along with access to the online application.

Both sending and receiving institution approve the Learning Agreement (LA).

Students will receive the acceptance documentation 2-1 months before the beginning of the stay.

VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMITS

Please be aware that the administration process of Czech visa can take more than 60 days after submitting the required documentation to the embassy/consulate. Thus, kindly instruct your students to start all necessary steps well in advance. Also, please arrange the approval of the LA on your side without a delay. Please note: students are obliged to take a min. of 51% of their courses from the offer at the host faculty. The rest (max. 49% of courses) can be selected from the other faculties (upon prior discussion with the respective faculty coordinator).

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

The standard language proficiency required is English, B2. However, please be aware that some faculties and study programmes require higher level of English and they might ask for a language certificate.

STUDENT AND STAFF SUPPORT

Students apply for accommodation at the CU Dormitories when submitting their online application. Students are accommodated in double rooms. For more information about the CU Dormitories check out the [website](#).

To give incoming students an opportunity to learn basics of Czech language, CU organizes an Intensive Czech Language Course. The course takes place 3 weeks before the beginning of each semester in an online/in-person form. Students are informed about the course well in advance. The Intensive Czech Language Course (ICLC) can be also included in the Learning Agreement. More information can be found [here](#).

Charles University offers a wide range of opportunities to be involved in its student life. For Erasmus+ students, there are **ESN CU Prague** and the **Buddy Program**.
